Industry members include designers, builders, yacht managers, sail makers, insurance providers, spar and winch manufacturers.

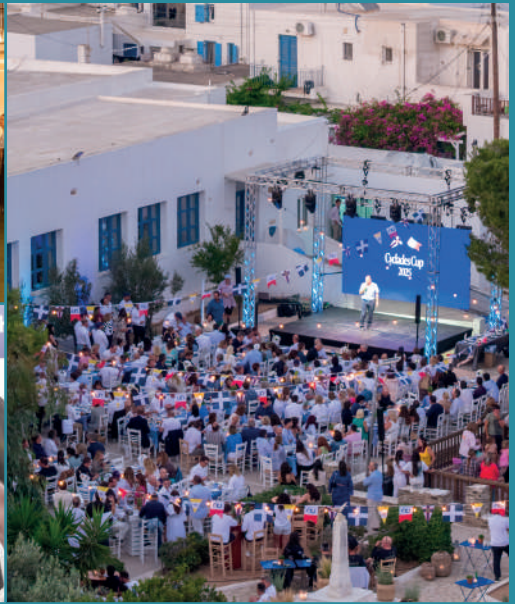
